FAILURE TO COMPLETE ALL REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN LOAD REFUSAL

Southern Idaho Solid Waste accepts Construction and Demolition (C&D) Waste into its C&D area at the Ohio Gulch Transfer Station. C&D waste contaminated with excluded materials may be diverted away from the C&D area, accepted as mixed MSW, and charged accordingly. SISW defines C&D Waste as the following:

Construction and Demolition Waste- "The waste building materials, packaging, vegetation, soil and rubble resulting from landclearing, construction, remodeling, repair and demolition operations on roads, houses, commercial buildings and other manmade structures."

Acceptable C&D Waste is composed of:

- 1. Waste from the building construction process.
- Waste resulting from the demolition or razing of buildings, roads and other manmade structures.
- 3. Waste from clearing and grubbing land for development.

C&D Waste can include, but is not limited to:

- Concrete, bricks, cinderblock
- Asphalt
- Untreated lumber, fenceposts, plywood
- Soil, rock, gravel, stone
- Metals (rebar, sheet metal, fixtures, wiring.

C&D Waste Excludes:

- Household items, food waste, clothing, toys
- Rolls of Carpet
- Yard Waste (Grass clippings, leaves, garden/landscaping waste)
- Furniture (Hot tubs, appliances, couches, mattresses, etc...)
- Tires

- Stumps, logs, shrubs, bushes
- Drywall, plaster, gypsum board
- Roofing materials (shingles/paper)
- Glass, ceramics, wall coverings
- Plastics, vinyl, insulation, siding
- Pressure treated/chemically preserved wood (railroad ties, utility poles, posts, pilings, decking, etc..)
- Liquids or Sludges
- Asbestos wastes
- Paint, solvents, pesticides, chemicals, oil, etc...
